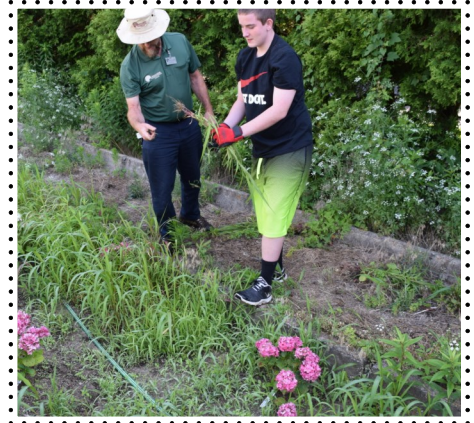


The Point Arc of Northern KY/Greater Cincinnati Summer Work Experience Program

The Point is excited to offer our second annual Summer Work Experience program for high school students in the area! The purpose of the 4 week program is to provide an in-depth, hands on work experience for teens and young adults with disabilities who are interested in strengthening and developing skills necessary for employment.



PROGRAM CONTENT

The Summer Work Experience contains three components each day: 1) Pre-Work meetings that include instruction in the areas of job exploration counseling, social and vocational skills needed for workplace readiness, employer feedback and job specific instruction, and self-advocacy 2) On-site work experience with job coaching, and 3) Post-work meetings to discuss and reflect on goals and progress. Participants will learn how to evaluate their progress, explore their interests, abilities, and work preferences, and strengthen interpersonal skills. It is our sincere hope that they will also experience an increase in their self-confidence as capable community members and employees.

Days/Time: Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 8:30 am - 12:30pm.

Length: June 18-July 13, 2018

One week at each of the following locations:

Spring Grove Cemetery and Arboretum, Milestones, Inc. Equestrian Achievement Program, Crayons to Computers, and Be Concerned

WHO

This program is available to high school students ages 14 and up, including students who graduate in the spring prior to the start of the summer program. Participants must have an intellectual/developmental disability, which includes Autism Spectrum Disorders. Transportation to and from the job sites is required and the fee for the program is \$250/week.

Note: Students can earn over 40 community service hours toward school requirements.
